Reimbursement

You can exceed the amount in one category and stay below the recommended amount in another as long as you do not exceed your total allowance. Allocations for the travel allowance are based on quotes for airline tickets for the period in question from the capital city in which you are located. Please note that we need receipts for amounts of less than \$50 and tax invoices for amounts of \$50 or over.
